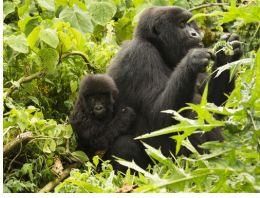

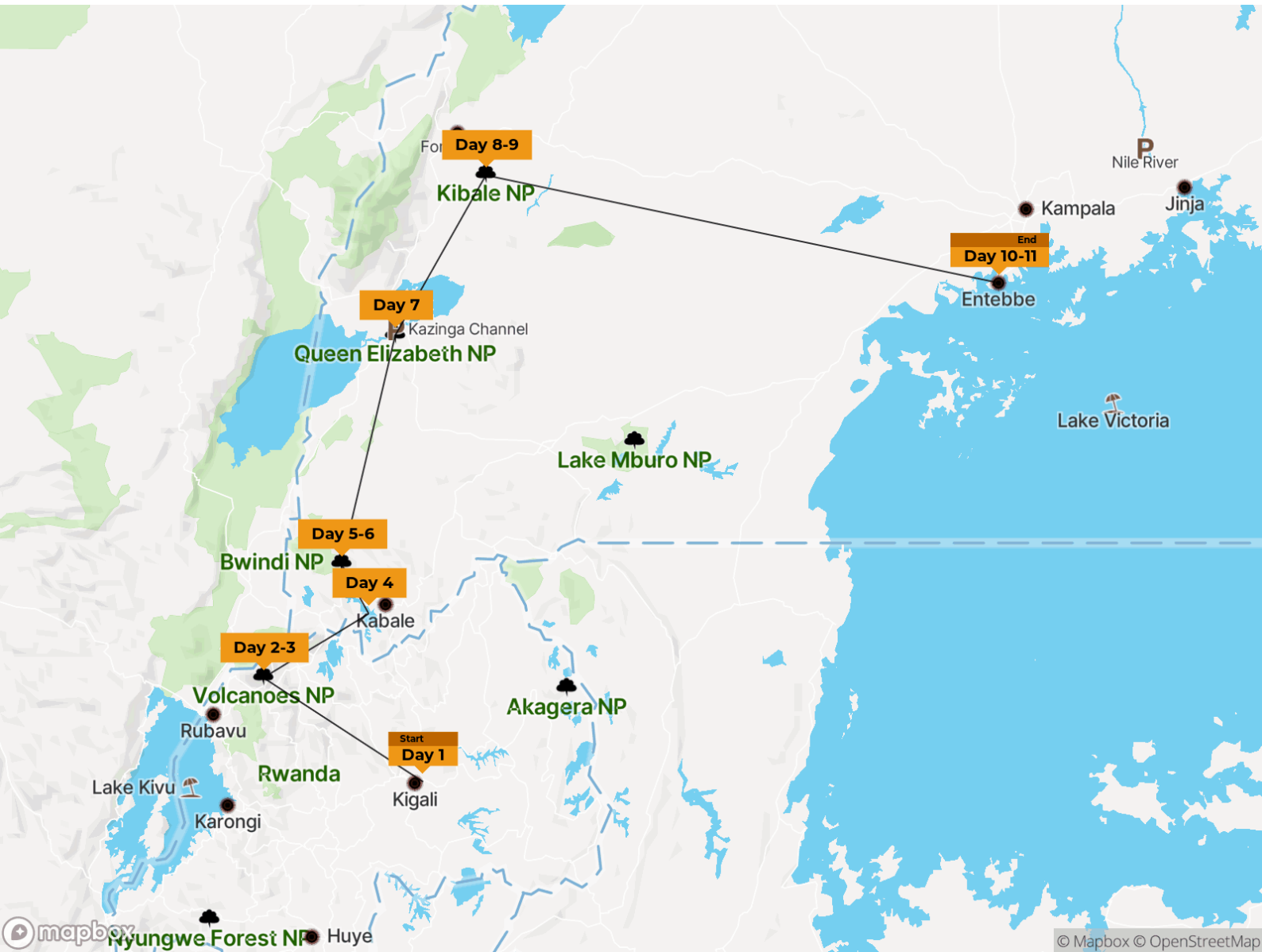

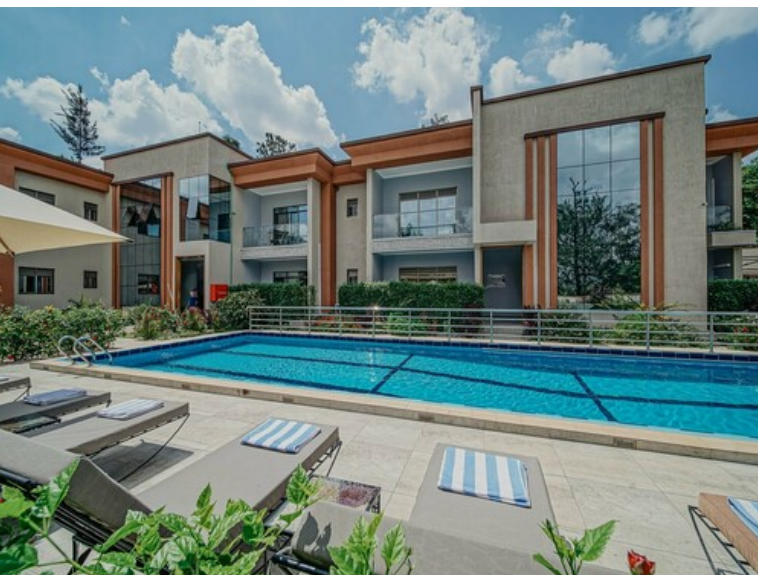

Volcanoes National Park

Volcanoes National Park protects the Rwandan portion of the Virungas, a chain of nine freestanding volcanoes that includes Africa sixth-highest mountain Karisimbi and supports over half the world's mountain gorillas. The jagged outline of the volcanic peaks dominates the skyline in all directions, and may seem familiar if you've seen the movie 'Gorillas in the Mist', which was filmed here. In order to protect the park's unique highland habitats, access is limited to a menu of thrilling guided foot excursions that leave in the morning. These include tracking to see habituated groups of mountain gorilla or golden monkey, and hikes through the jungle to the lofty volcanic calderas.

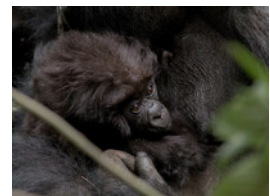

Relax on the beach with a cold beer, enjoy a tasty curry made with local freshwater shrimps, ramble or bird watch through the surrounding countryside, or explore the islands by boat.

Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Prepare to be blown away by Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. Not only is this mountainous rainforest utterly gorgeous, but it has also been recognized as a Unesco World Heritage Site on account of its rich biodiversity and wealth of unique plants and animals. Bwindi is best known for supporting roughly 45% of the world's remaining mountain gorillas, but other wildlife includes the attractive L'Hoest's monkey, a small population of forest elephants, and a seriously impressive checklist of 350 bird species.

Queen Elizabeth National Park

Set on the Rift Valley floor in view of the snow-capped Rwenzori peaks, Queen Elizabeth National Park offers plenty of variety to safari-goers. On the Kasenyi and Ishasha Plains, large herds of Uganda kob, the national antelope, stand on constant guard for the lions that feed on them. Lakes Edward and George, together with the connecting Kazinga Channel, support around 5,000 hippos and an abundance of waterbirds, as well as being a magnet for thirsty elephant and buffalo herds.

Boat Trip, Kazinga Channel

We join a boat trip following the Kazinga Channel to its confluence with Lake Edward. Hemmed in by steep walls and set below the glacial Rwenzori peaks, Kazinga is home to large numbers of hippo, as well as elephant, buffalo, waterbuck and Uganda kob. Lion, leopard and giant forest hog are more occasional. The birdlife is reliably fabulous.

Our base for exploring Queen Elizabeth National Park is Buffalo Safari Resort, a small and relaxed lodge notable for its view over a muddy waterhole that regularly attracts wildlife such as elephant, buffalo and giant forest hog.

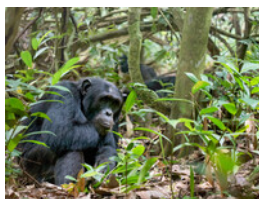
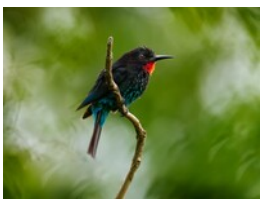

Kibale National Park

Kibale National Park

Kibale National Park is one of East Africa's most important chimp strongholds. This forested park is home to roughly 1,000 of these charismatic apes, the largest population in the region, and the chances of a close-up sighting are excellent. Even if you don't manage to see chimps, listen out for their unforgettable pant-hoot call as it resonates through the forest interior. Other wildlife you might encounter in Kibale includes monkeys such as Uganda mangabey, Uganda red colobus and red-tailed monkey, and an astounding 370 bird species.

→ In **Queen Elizabeth National Park**, your early morning game drive gets you close to the wildlife when they're most active, and the landscapes are at their most beautiful.

This small lodge, built around a restored 1950s homestead, also offers great views of the surrounding tea plantations and nearby Nyabikere Lake.

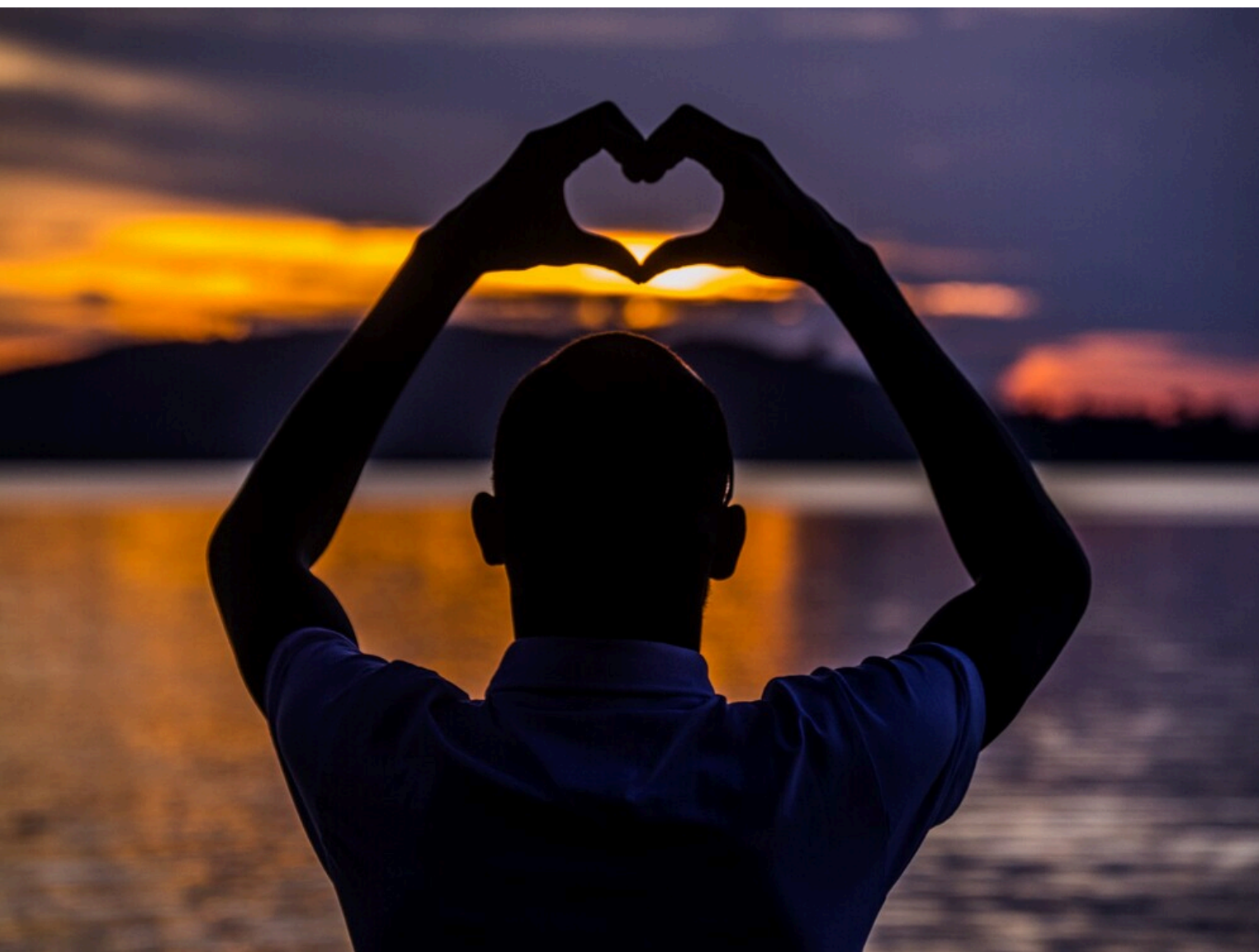
